DOUBT OR UNWILLINGNESS

Thomas demands proof. He wants personal and concrete evidence. Not just words of his trusted disciples, but he wants physical evidence that he can touch.

COMPASSIONATE COMMAND

Jesus didn't shame Thomas for his unbelief, but instead offers a kind, compassionate response in proving his resurrection. Thomas had a weak area. He struggled with his faith and Jesus. And fueled by love Jesus met Thomas in his weakness.

Even though he extends mercy and grace, Jesus still commands Thomas with a gentle rebuke.

COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Before group starts, who can share the Memory Verse?

Read John 20:24-31. What stands out in this passage, and what stuck out to you most from the sermon on Sunday?

Thomas struggled with believing what Jesus said would happen was really happening. His demand for physical proof of Jesus's resurrection did not have to be answered. However, in His mercy, Jesus compassionately answers Thomas's doubts and rebukes him, telling him to believe. In what ways do you struggle with unbelief? How can the truths and promises in God's word give you the "proof" that you need to trust fully in his goodness and plan for your life?

Your Life Mission

What relationships or conversations are upcoming that you could use prayer for?

End the evening in a time of prayer, praying through the theme of the night using the P.R.A.Y. model with your group. Pray for these people you have mentioned and for your heart and plan as you pursue them in love.

Preaching the Gospel to Yourself (Matthew 6.9, 10)

o Always begin your time of prayer focusing on God's goodness, who He is, and what He has done for us. Pray truths from this week's text.

Repent and Confess (Matthew 6.12)

o Real repentance begins where blame-shifting stops. Your circumstances don't need to change, your heart needs to change. Confess any particular sin that prevents you from walking out what God calls us to in the text, or any other particular sin you are wanting to fight. Ask Him to help you have strength to repent and run towards Him.

Ask for Provision (Matthew 6.11-13)

o Ask God for new perspective and for the things that you need. Once our hearts are fixed on Him, we can ask Him to help us with our needs. When your heart is begin filled with the Gospel first, your asking will be far more in line with God's desires and will. Ask Him to work in the relationships in your life that you are hoping to share God's love with.

Yield with Thanksgiving (Matthew 6.10)

End your prayer by giving God thanks for His faithfulness and ask Him to help you trust and yield to His work and ways.
