COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

What stuck out to you the most or was the most impactful from the message on Sunday?
In your own words, what does it mean to have a "partnership of the Gospel?" Read Philippians 1:3-5.
Read 1 Corinthians 9:23 and Titus 3:4-7. Why are we called to participate? Why are we on this partnership, or mission with God? And most importantly (1 Corinthians 15:1-3), what's the driving motivation to join in on God's mission?
Read Philippians 1:12, Philippians 1:20b, Philippians 3:17. What are your thoughts about Paul's life and participation of the Gospel?
In what ways did the early church in Philippi partner in the Gospel? Read 2 Corinthians 8:5, Philippians 2:25
Unfortunately, many Christians view their involvement like spectators. What did they give for the sake of the Gospel and how can we participate like them? Read 2 Corinthians 8:5, Philippians 2:25-30. Philippians 4:15-18, 2 Corinthians 8:1.
Are you more of a consumer or participant of the Gospel? When it comes to being on mission with God, are you sitting in the stands watching the game, or playing in the game? And are you willing to get involved in each other's lives and open up your life for the sake of the Gospel? If not, why? What areas of your life are you watching the game and not participating in the Gospel?
Close out the group by spending some time in prayer. This might be difficult for some of you, but maybe you need to confess of having been a fan in the stands, watching the game. Pray for one another and ask God to help give you a desire to play in the game.
