THE AUTHORITY OF JESUS

Matthew 9.18-34

Again, we are seeing that Jesus is proving Himself as being the One who has authority over all things. And yet again, we are seeing the disbelief and cynicism of the Pharisees, whose blindness towards their own self-righteousness and their hard-heartedness is preventing them from seeing the truth of Christ.

POWER OVER DEATH

One of the most important truths that Jesus is showing to the people in His day is the very truth and fact that He even has authority over death. For those who believe in Him, He has promised eternal life, an eternal life that cannot end, even by the temporary interruption of death.

John 11.25-27 // Isaiah 35.5, 6 // Hebrews 2.6-18 Romans 6.9, 8.10, 11 // Revelation 1.17, 18, 21.3-5

OUR ROLE AS AMBASSADORS

From many verses such as Hebrews 2.6-18, Isaiah 35.5, 6, and John 3.16, 17, and countless others, we see that the Son of David was indeed sent to save. And yet, almost more improbably, we see that He has come not just to set us free from death, but that He has come to save us so that He could send us.

COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Read Matthew 9:18:34 . What stuck out to you in these verses or was most impactful from the message on Sunday?
In our passage this week, we learn how Jesus made a dead woman alive. Read Isaiah 35:5-6, Ephesians 2:1-9 and Colossians 2:13. Explain in your own words what it means to be once be spiritually dead and now be alive in Christ.
Read John 11:25-27 . Jesus asks a great question, "Do you believe this?" If you're a disciple of Jesus, of course you will say "Yes!" of course. By the way you live out your faith, how do you show the world that you believe this?
Read John 3:17 , the verse after the "great touchdown" verse. Here we learn that Jesus Himself, God in human flesh is sent to save. What can you learn from His example here?
How does knowing, believing and trusting that your King Jesus has authority over death and is alive empower you for daily God-glorifying, upright living?
Read 2 Cornithians 5:17-21. What ministry has Christ given to us?
Why were you saved, made alive in Christ? For what purpose?
Read Ephesians 2:10 with Ephesians 2:1-9 in mind. How does knowing that we have been saved to be sent change the way you spend your time, energy and resources?
Read Matthew 28:18 . Are you answering the command of Jesus to make disciples both locally and globally? If not, why? Where's the hiccup?
Pray that the sovereign God of the universe would either start or continue to reveal his great commission to you and what it specifically and practically looks
