There are a few ways you can join us:

- 1. Written hard copies of the plan available at church.
- 2. PDF will be available and viewable online on our website.
- 3. Daily reminder through the **PrayerMate App**,
- 4. Published online on our **Facebook** and **Twitter** page.
- 5. Available via email to your inbox every day.

Additionally, pick up the book, **How to Read the Bible Book by Book** by Gordon and Fee. Find it on **Amazon.com**, or purchase it at church (when in stock).

Will you pray with us?

In addition to daily bible reading, the **PrayerMate App** will also let us know what prayers are being asked for. To subscribe to **Life Mission's Prayer Journal**, follow these steps:

- 1. On either iOS or Android, download the free PrayerMate App.
- 2. Click on the settings icon (the little gear/cog icon in the corner), go to the bottom and click "subscribe to online feeds." Then select "churches," then select "US churches," and find "Life Mission Church." Then click "subscribe to feed."
- 3. Next, it will ask you to add it to a category. For now, just add it to "Personal Growth." Soon we will have a little video tutorial on how to better set up the **PrayerMate App**.
- 4. For now, you can just back out to the main page. If the Life Mission feed doesn't show up, shut down the app and restart it. You should now see our feed show up when you swipe over. Every day, a new Bible passage and Psalm reading will pop up, including a mini-tutorial on how to "pray the Psalms," as well as a daily prayer request for the church.

Will you fight with us and for us?

Here are a few of the ways we would love to see you deepen your communion with Christ through His body:

- 1. Joining a Community Group.
- 2. Initiating and committing to a **Fight Club**. Even if you "don't know where to start," initiate simply by asking someone in your **Community Group**, or at church, or at work, to get together to discuss faith and encourage each other.
