1. JOY COMES WITH THE KINGDOM OF GOD

Luke 2:10-14, Isaiah 9:2-7

The kingdom of God = the effective reign of God; it's where what God wants done is what is done

"The kingdom of God is what things would be like if Jesus ran everything and if his will was done everywhere... We say the kingdom has come when the Lord totally has his way, when he is running the show." -- Rich Nathan

2. RIGHTEOUSNESS, PEACE, AND JOY IN THE KINGDOM OF GOD

Romans 14:17

17 For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking but of righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.

 The promised coming of the Spirit in the Kingdom would bring righteousness, from which would spring peace

Isaiah 32:15-17

Righteousness

Righteousness in the Kingdom is a gift, not earned, but received and then put into practice

Romans 1:16-17, 2 Corinthians 5:21, Romans 5:17

Peace

God's Peace doesn't mean not being in wartime. It's a much broader word that describes a blessing that will sustain you right in the middle of wartime and difficulty.

The Hebrew word is shalom (both adjective and substantive), meaning, primarily, "soundness," "health," but coming also to signify "prosperity," well-being in general, all good in relation to both man and God. In early times, to a people harassed by foes, peace was the primary blessing. -- International Standard Bible Encyclopaedia

Joy

Joy, Rejoice defined: "...the feeling of exultant gladness which often finds outward expression in such actions as leaping, shouting, and singing. Joy is repeatedly shown to be the natural outcome of fellowship with God." - International Standard Bible Encyclopedia

3. THE JOY OF THE KING

Hebrews 1:8-9, Hebrews 12:1-2

- Pursuing happiness/joy as an end in itself is one of the surest ways to miss happiness
- Pursuing the Glory of God by fulfilling the work Jesus has called us to is one of the surest ways to find happiness/joy

John 17:3-5, John 15:9-11

 There is great joy at seeing people who are the fruit of our fulfilling the work Jesus has sent us to do, fulfilling their own work. In other words, Joy is like candle light – it gets brighter every time a new candle is lit...joy grows when it is shared.

3 John 4. Luke 10:17-22

4. LIVING IN THE JOY OF THE KING

- Since Joy is an expected experience in the Kingdom of God, I can use it as a "spiritual thermometer".
- I can lose my joy when I am pursuing happiness anywhere other than in God Himself
- I can lose my joy when I let worry and stress (frustration at my inability to control life) reign
- I can lose my joy when I have not been in the harvest. There is joy in the Harvest Fields!
- Pray for the in breaking of the Kingdom, including the Joy of the King "Your kingdom come, your will be done"

> Use the power of choice to fix my attention on that which is eternal

2 Corinthians 4:17-18

Philippians 4:8

Intentionally look for any and every opportunity to touch somebody with the Kingdom of God in deed and in word: pay attention to people's needs and always offer to pray, inviting God's Kingdom to break into their situation.
