WHAT IS MISSION, AND WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

If Vision identifies a problem and the end goal in light of that problem, then mission is the answer to "what do we need to be doing in order to be a part of the solution?" If we want to see God's glory among the nations go to the least, the last, and the lost, and if He has chosen that it is *through the church* that this is to happen (**Ephesians 3.10**), then we must be a church who is committed to making disciples who make disciples, both locally and globally, who are saved, equipped, and sent by the Gospel.

WHAT IS LIFE MISSION'S LIFE MISSION?

Romans 10.13-17

Paul traces a logical path by doing some "reverse engineering." If people are saved by hearing the Gospel and calling upon the Name of the Lord, they have to first hear it. But they can't hear it if people don't go, but people won't go unless they are being equipped and sent.

Therefore, the life mission of Life Mission is to make disciples who make disciples, both locally and globally, who are saved, equipped, and sent by the Gospel.


COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Read Revelation 7.9-17, 1 Peter 2.9, 10. What was impactful from the sermon on Sunday or stuck out in the these verses? Read Matthew 28:18-20. What stuck out to you the most in these verses or was the most impactful from the message on Sunday? Why is having a specific mission, an action plan so important for Christians as well as for churches and organizations? Without cheating, what would you say the Mission (what we need to do) of Life Mission Church is? How do you think we are doing with that Mission, and what specific ways are we pursuing it? Re-read Matthew 28:18-20 and 2 Timothy 2:2. What do you think about the Mission of our church? Is it biblical? Does it align with God commands for His church to do? Why or why not? In your own words, how would you define a disciple? Revelation 7:9-17. Last week we discussed that the vision of Life Mission church is to "alorify God among the nations to the least, last and the lost". Now read, Matthew 24:14. What has to happen before we can see God's glory among the nations? What is your role in seeing it happen? How is your life as a Christian impacting your unsaved friends and family with the Gospel? If it's not impacting those around you, why not?

End group and your personal study time with prayer. Pray using the P.R.A.Y. model. PREACH the Gospel, reminding yourself that we were once enemies of God. But now, He has saved us to be sent out into the world to glorify His Great Name. Then confess and repent of any sin. Then ASK for the Holy Spirit, who is your Helper and with you to continue to increase your desire to obey the Great Commission. Ask Him to help you turn to prayer more, the Word more and your Gospel-centered friends. Lastly, YIELD, with thanksgiving.
