# WILL HEAVEN BE BORING?

Philippians 3.17-21 // Colossians 3.1-4

## SET YOUR MIND ON THINGS ABOVE

Philippians 3.17-21, 4.8, 9 // Colossians 3.1-4

As citizens of heaven, we are to keep our eyes fixed on the future, our heavenly hope. But if we don't know much about what it will be like, we will have nothing to even fix our eyes on! We can't get homesick if we don't know what home is like.

# WHAT WILL HEAVEN BE LIKE?

As a general rule of thumb, the best starting place is to ask these questions:

- What does the bible say?
- What does it forbid?
- Will it glorify God?
- Is it inherently sinful or evil?
- Does it coincide with the idea of continuity?
- Was it a part of God's "very good" creation and design?

**What Will Our Bodies be Like?** Jesus is our example here. He is the "first fruit," which means that if a farmer saw an orange on a tree, he could expect more oranges to follow. Whatever Jesus' resurrected body is like, we should expect similar.

Where is Heaven? It is commonly believed that the earth will be obliterated and we will live in a heaven that is somewhere in the sky or another dimension. But what does the bible say?

God's plan was to destroy the curse, not His creation. Satan's plan is to maintain the curse, and destroy creation.

**What Will it be Like?** There will be a tremendous amount of continuity. What God had declared as "very good," will either be restored, renewed, or made even better.

C.S. Lewis rightly noted that the Christians who were most thinking of and obsessed over their eternal future were the ones who did the most earthly good on this planet. Their focus on eternity caused them to turn and run from their selfish motivations and pursue Kingdom advancement. He famously said, "aim at Heaven and you will get earth 'thrown in'; aim at earth and you will get neither."

# COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Before your group starts, is there anyone who can share the Memory Verse?

- 1. Read Philippians 3:17-21, Philippians 4:8-9 and Colossians 3:1-4. What stuck out to you from these verses or from the sermon on Sunday?
- 2. We have all thought about Heaven. What has your perspective of Heaven been? What do you think it will look like? What did you think Heaven was going to be like when you were a child? After hearing the sermon has your view on Heaven changed?
- 3. Read Colossians 3:1-4 again. In this passage, we are told to "Set our minds on things that are above." What does this mean? \_\_\_
- **4.** What do you tend to daydream about? Eternal things? Earthly things?
- 5. If we were to truly have our mind on Heaven, how would that change the way we handle situations in our daily life?
- 6. As Pastor Jobey mentioned in his sermon, the bible tells us that we are foreigners and strangers in this land. Do you feel that way? Are you living for the now or the future?
- 7. C.S. Lewis said "Aim at Heaven and you will get earth thrown in; aim at earth and you will get neither." How can having a heavenly aim help you to fulfill God's plan for you in this life? Read Matthew 6:33-34. If we seek first his kingdom, what are we promised? Do you believe this? Spend time in your group sharing areas of your life that this proves difficult for you and thanking God for the promise of his faithfulness.

Bonus Question: What question do you have about Heaven? As a group, have fun trying to think through a biblical answer. Use the probing questions in the sermon notes as well as Scripture you can think of in order to maybe find a possible answer.
