BEHOLD, THE AWE AND WONDER OF THE FATHER

John 1.1-18

WHAT IS THE FATHER LIKE?

When we consider the characteristics of God, we must remember that God has perfect integrity, so His characteristics aren't compartmentalized aspects of Himself, but they are perfectly integrated.

Isaiah 40:9-40.31

God's Life Doesn't Change:

- God does not grow older, nor does He grow in power or wisdom.
- He clearly can't change for the worse, but neither can He for the better.

God's Character Doesn't Change:

- He cannot become more holy, nor more true.
- His Name is "I AM WHO I AM," because He always was, and always will be who He is.

God's Truth Does Not Change:

- We say things we regret, and our opinions change.
- But God's Words are always true, fixed in the heavens.

God's Purposes Do Not Change:

- "The plans of the LORD stand firm forever, the purposes of His heart through all generations." Psalm 33.11
- God does not call audibles or change direction. Isaiah 46.8-10

God's Majesty Does Not Change:

- God is personal, but He is also majestic and all powerful.
- Whatever you picture of God, it is too small; nothing is like Him.
- " 'To whom will you compare Me, that I may be like him?' says the Lord."
 Isaiah 40.25

God's Love Does Not Change:

- It is shown in His choice to create, forgive, and show grace.
- It is shown in His eternal choice to save sinners by sending His own Son.
- His love fuels His wrath, wisdom, plan, ways, etc.

WHAT DOES THE FATHER DO?

As the "head" of the Trinity, it is from God the Father by which all blessings flow. It is to and for His glory by which all things are made, and His glory is the purpose behind even the sending of the Son for our salvation.

We are not the center point of our own salvation. You are saved to put God's glory on display.

RECOVERING OUR VIEW OF THE FATHER

Many have a bad view of the Father. Maybe it's our own earthly father, or maybe we see God as a God that we owe and work for. Yet when we get this previous picture of God's love, majesty, and purposes, we can be in awe; and it doesn't stop there.

God the Father did not just design and create all of these plans and works, but as part of His design, and in His wisdom, He decides to let us partake not just of salvation, but in the great joy of being a part of others coming to salvation.


COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Before your group starts, is there anyone who can share the Memory Verse?

- 1. As a recap of last week's message, why is the Trinity necessary for salvation to work? What is God the Father's role in this?
- 2. Read John 1.1-18. What stuck out to you from this verse or from the sermon on Sunday?
- 3. Pastor Jobev shared about God's unchanging nature. Can you list some ways God does not change? How can knowing these truths about God change the way we live our lives?
- 4. What are some of the things the Father does? Read James 1:17, Ephesians 1:3, John 17:6, 1 Peter 1:18-21, John 5:27, and Philippians 2:9-11.
- 5. Some of us might have an unclear view of the Father, possibly because of our own relationships with our earthly fathers. What did you learn from the sermon to help you recover or deepen your view of your heavenly Father?
- 6. Pastor Jobey asked some questions towards the end of his sermon to help us probe our hearts about our attitude and our perception of the Father. Spend some time going through these with one another.
 - -Do you have a hard time addressing God as "Father"?
 - -Do you pray primarily to Jesus?

 - -Do you meditate on the greatness and majesty of God the Father?
