BEHOLD, THE AWE AND WONDER OF THE SON

John 1.1-18

THE WORD BECAME FLESH

John 1.1-18 // Colossians 2.9 // Hebrews 1.1-13

Your words are intrinsically integrated into who you are. You cannot be separated from your words. Jesus even said that what comes from our mouth proceeds from the heart. This means that our words *reveal* who we are and what is deep within us.

ALL THINGS THROUGH HIM

John 1.3. 4

We know that every good and perfect gift comes from the Father, but they all come through the Son. What exactly does this mean? Consider the cross. The cross did not just simply purchase our salvation (yet that alone makes it glorious), but it also purchased every other good and perfect gift for us.

Upon our initial sin in the Garden, God could have enacted swift and immediate punishment and justice. But He had already chosen to set forth a plan in motion to send His Son to die in our place. Because of this plan, He could show patience and longsuffering with sinful enemies, because He knew that not only will justice be done, but mercy would also be given. Due to this, instead of giving us death, He gives us air to breathe and food to eat. Instead of giving us immediate punishment, He gives us 70+ years to enjoy friends, family, and joy. All this was not only made through the Son, but it is sustained by the Son and because of His cross.

The next time you hope for swift and immediate justice to be done against someone, first thank God that swift and immediate justice was not done against you.

THE FINAL AND DECISIVE WORD OF GOD

It can be difficult to go to God as our Father for a number of reasons. Maybe you see God as distant, or as a boss, or as someone who you can never please. Or we listen to other people's voices, or our own voices, and we hear accusations of being failures and unworthy.

But of all these words spoken and listened to, since Jesus is the First and the Last, it means He is also the First Word and Last Word concerning your salvation and identity.

COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Before your group starts, is there anyone who can share the Memory Verse?

- 1. Read **John 1:1-18**. What stuck out to you from the message on Sunday?
- 2. A lot is wrapped into the Scripture above (John 1:1-18). Broadly speaking, what does this Scripture reveal to us?
- 3. Think about the concept of the Word becoming flesh. What is your perception of Jesus' nature, character, and personality? As you dig deeper into His life and His experiences, does this change how you view Jesus as a human, but also, how does He reveal God the Father?
- 4. Read John 5:30-31, 6:38, 17:1-2, and Philippians 2:11. What was the mission Christ came to accomplish? What are the roles and responsibilities of Christ?
- 5. On Sunday, Pastor Jobey talked about how the cross did not just purchase our salvation, but everything else, down to the air we breathe. In your words, how did the cross purchase these things? If it weren't for the cross, how might our lives really be, not just spiritually, but physically?
- 6. The Old Testament sacrifices temporarily would "put off" God's wrath for another year, because God knew there would eventually be a permanent sacrifice. In the same way, God "put off" His judgment, even of unbelievers, during the course of our life, instead giving us blessings during that time, because He planned that an ultimate sacrifice would eventually come. How has growing in the "awe of Jesus" becoming a man, the Word becoming flesh, changed you? How does it change the way you go about evangelizing or disciplining those that God has specifically put in your life?

Spend time as a group sharing opportunities you have had with those you have written down to pray for and reach out to. Pray for them as a group.
