# SOLA FIDE: "FAITH ALONE"

Romans 1.16, 17

#### HOW DO WE GET TO HEAVEN?

When Martin Luther first read **Romans 1.16, 17,** he used to hate this verse, because he thought that it meant that we must first become perfect people before we could have faith in God. And even though he was a very religious monk, he still knew deep down that there was no way he could be good enough.

Romans 3.21-28

And that part he got right. But what he got wrong is what it means for "the righteous to live by faith."

**Redemption:** This is a business term. Today we may see something like, "turn in this coupon to redeem your prize." It means to claim or purchase.

**Propitiation:** This means to satisfy. A coupon could "satisfy" the requirement to redeem the prize. In this case, a payment must be made in order to purchase us from the slavery of sin and death, and satisfy the debt we owe.

**Justification:** to declare as righteous. "Just as if I'd never sinned," but also "just as if I'd always obeyed."

#### WHY IS THIS SO IMPORTANT?

You and I will still fail, we will still sin. Every single day, until the day we die. We can either live in the uncomfortable limbo of not knowing if God still loves us and is going to change His mind, or we can stand in faith and confidence.

### SO WHAT IS FAITH?

So when the devil throws your sins in your face and declares that you deserve death and hell, tell him this: "I admit that I deserve death and hell, what of it? For I know One who suffered and made satisfaction on my behalf. His name is Jesus Christ, Son of God, and where He is there I shall be also!

# **COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK**

Before your group starts, is there anyone who can share the Memory Verse?

Read Romans 3.21-28. What stands out to you in this passage, and what stuck out to you most from the sermon on Sunday?

Now read Galatians 2.20, 21, and Romans 8.1. When you struggle in sin, do you often feel condemnation or shame, or feel like God is unhappy with you? How do these verses help combat those thoughts or feelings?

On Sunday, Jobey mentioned the difference between what is "true" and what is "truth." Read through the first Martin Luther quote in the "So What is Faith" section of the sermon notes. Give a real example from your life of something that is "true," but in keeping with Luther's quote, how you can put your faith in what is "truth" in order to stand in confidence and not condemnation.

Jobey said that faith isn't just hoping for something that may not actually happen, and it faith is not a mystical way we make things happen, as we can "will them" into existence. What are ways that you have misunderstood faith, only maybe to be let down?

Read Hebrews 11.1. How does this short verse teach what biblical faith is?

Why is faith the only possible way we can receive justification, and why is it so rock

solid to trust in?

Close the night in prayer with each other. Pray for each other's faith. Pray that each person would have a deeper faith, firstly by "Knowing" the truth, then by

"Believing" the truth, and then finally by "Trusting" the truth.
