## **COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK**

Before your group starts, is there anyone who can share the Memory Verse?

Read Ephesians 1.4-12. What stands out to you in this passage, and what stuck out to you most from the sermon on Sunday?

At the beginning of the sermon, Pastor Jobey asked everyone to take time to write down the things that are their goals. If you didn't already, write down what things you most hope are in your future, things you aim for, are your goals, your hopes, your dreams. What are the things that drive you and motivate you?

Which of these things do you think have a particular power or strength over your pursuits, behavior, and overall living? Which have or can easily become an idol, and in what ways can these things become "more central" than even God?

What are some specific ways that making these "good" things into "god" things can have a detrimental effect on your life?

Does the concept of God wanting to be glorified, or that He desires our worship, sit uneasy with you? Why or why not?

Explain in your own words why God's "self-centeredness" is actually a good thing.

Read Isaiah 48.9-11 and 61.3. How do these verses portray the effect of God being glorified? In other words, what happens when God is shown for who He is?

In what ways does the cross of Christ best display God's glory? \_\_\_

Take time looking at your list you wrote, and asking God to help you put those things in proper order. Ask Him to show you how you might have those things more glorify Him as you aim to keep Him as center, and allow those things to serve your goal to glorify Him in all that you do.
