Luke 24.13-35

#### THE WHOLE BIBLE POINTS TO JESUS

#### Luke 24.13-27 // Genesis 3.14, 15

From the very beginning, man has turned from God. But God, even from Genesis, promised to make a way for salvation and forgiveness. The entire bible is the redemptive story of mankind that God put forward to display His glory. Every page somehow points to our need for a Savior, and God's faithfulness towards unfaithful enemies.

Despite man's continual rebellion, God would remain patient; He would stay true to His promise that He would send a Rescuer to us in order to save us.

#### <u>ISAIAH 53</u>

God did, however, prepare the way for us through His Word. Through many prophecies given to show us what the Messiah would look like and do, He prepared us to know what to look for.

**Isaiah 53** is the fourth "Servant Song" in Isaiah, which depicts the coming Messiah as God's Servant. Historically, even in ancient Jewish commentaries, it was considered to be about the Messiah. But after the life and death of Christ, it made many Jewish scholars uncomfortable, and other meanings were debated. At one point, it was taken (among other chapters of the OT) out of the yearly synagogue reading, and so throughout much of Jewish history, Isaiah 53 was very unknown.

#### SO HOW WILL WE KNOW?

The Jews missed the Messiah, despite the many prophecies, because they did not seek Him by faith, but rather sought God in their own good works and sought a God that *they* wanted.

Even though we have so much at our fingertips concerning the Gospel, we could also fall into the trap of "missing" the Messiah. Though we know Him by name and call Him our Lord,

If we are looking to Him to be our Personal Assistant, rather than our King, we will be surprised to only know Him as our Judge.

# COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Before your group starts, is there anyone who can share the Memory Verse?

Read Luke 24.13-35. What stands out to you in this passage, and what stuck out to you most from the sermon on Sunday?

How does knowing that the whole bible ultimately points to Jesus change the way that you approach reading the Word? What does this tell you about God's design and purpose for His Word?

#### Preaching the Gospel to Yourself

How does the truth from this text and sermon point you back to Christ? What particular truth can help keep you focused on the Gospel?

What is a real life and current situation you are in that this truth can be applied to, and how?

#### Repent and Confess

What do you see in this truth that exposes a particular sin or behavior? How have you been "missing the Messiah" in your day to day life?

#### Ask for Provision

In light of this truth, what do you need to ask for from the Lord? What fruit of the Spirit are you needing?

#### **Your Life Mission**

In the video, we saw examples of people who have not quite heard enough about who this Savior is. Before you close the group with prayer, what opportunities are coming up that you could use prayer for as it pertains to sharing your faith or intentionally engaging with others with a Gospel focus and goal?

End the evening in a time of prayer, praying through the theme of the night using the **P.R.A.Y.** model with your group. Make sure to end your time of prayer **Yielding** with **Thanksgiving** for God's sovereignty and plan for your life.


