Isaiah 53.7-9

THE HUMBLE LAMB OF GOD

Isaiah 53.7-9 // Matthew 27.57-60, 26.57-68

When the wool on a lamb would get too thick, a shepherd would have the wool shorn off. This was then sold or used to make clothing. The sheep, then, was essentially, bare, exposed, naked, and nothing to keep it warm. But lambs are docile and submissive; they wouldn't kick like a mule or be hard to tame like a wild horse. They would trustingly hold still while they were being shorn.

SHORN FOR OUR SHAME

John 10.15-17 // Hebrews 12.1-3

But this Lamb of God was not forced to be shorn; rather, He willfully laid His life down for the other sheep. And He did this "for the joy set before Him." He wanted to be shorn so that He could clothe us; by our sin, we had been shorn and stripped, exposed in shame, and by His sacrifice we are now covered in His pure white wool.

It was not just those in the first century that were His accusers. We, too, are His accusers, and He opens not His mouth against us. Instead, He defends you.

God the Father is the Judge, Satan is the prosecutor, and Christ is our Defense Lawyer. He is our Advocate who stands before the Judge and pleads the power, worth, and riches of His blood that has covered our sin. And the Judge, because He is good and just, agrees with the worthy payment and declares us "innocent."

CHRIST OUR EXAMPLE

Hebrews 12.1-3 // 1 Peter 2.18-25

This great truth also serves as a practical implication in our own lives. As Christ didn't speak against His accusers, we also are to have a "big picture" of life and show humility, patience, and have our identity in Christ.

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COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Before your group starts, is there anyone who can share the Memory Verse?

Read Isaiah 53.7-9. What stands out to you in this passage, and what stuck out to you most from the sermon on Sunday? _

What are ways in your life that you have also become one of Christ's "accusers?"

Preaching the Gospel to Yourself

Read Revelation 12.10 and 1 John 3.20, and 1 John 2.1. How does the truth from these, the Isaiah text, and sermon point you back to Christ? What particular truth can help keep you focused on the Gospel?

What is a real life and current situation you are in that this truth can be applied to, and how?

Repent and Confess

What do you see in this truth that exposes a particular sin or behavior? Maybe a way you are currently an "accuser of Christ"? Are you still standing naked and ashamed, and your heart stubbornly condemns you and you don't believe Jesus?

Ask for Provision

In light of this truth, what do you need to ask for from the Lord? What fruit of the Spirit are you needing?

Your Life Mission

Before you close the group with prayer, what opportunities are coming up that you could use prayer for as it pertains to sharing your faith or intentionally engaging with others with a Gospel focus and goal?

End the evening in a time of prayer, praying through the theme of the night using the P.R.A.Y. model with your group. Make sure to end your time of prayer Yielding with Thanksgiving for God's sovereignty and plan for your life.
