GOD'S WISDOM IN THE REDEMPTION OF HIS ENEMIES

Ephesians 1.7-10 // December 16, 2018

SOMEONE MUST PAY

Upon their rebellion, Adam and Eve lost the "deed" to the earth, and became slaves and prisoners of sin and death. The only way out would be for someone else to redeem them, to purchase their freedom. Justice must be done because of their crime, and the payment requires that blood must be shed.

Genesis 3.20-24

Initially, they tried to "cover" their sin by sewing fig leaves, but their own efforts could never do, Graciously, God put His wrath upon animals who were shed to cover them, to both show the severity of sin but also to show His patience. But animals could not repay, ultimately.

NO ONE CAN DO IT

Throughout the Old Testament, there are glimmers of hope that a man would be raised up to be the savior of the Jews. But no one can do it.

Romans 3.9-12 // Revelation 5.1-14

It is God himself who in holy wrath needs to be propitiated, God himself who in holy love undertook to do the [satisfying...He devised the plan] propitiating, and God himself who in the person of his Son died for the propitiation of our sins. Thus God took his own loving initiative to appease his own righteous anger by bearing this anger by his own self in his own Son when he took our place and died for us - John Stott, "the Cross of Christ"

BETTER THAN BEFORE

Do you ever wonder if, since Adam and Eve sinned in the perfect Garden, that we would be able to sin in heaven? There is a difference between Adam and Eve and how we will be in our eternal state, however.

Adam was uncorrupted, but *not* incorruptible. Through Adam's (and our own) sin, we are corrupted. Jesus is not only uncorrupted, but *incorruptible.* When we are made one with Him, we'll be raised not only as uncorrupted, but now *incorruptible.*

Adam was never "in Christ." He was only simply "in Adam." When we believe in this plan of salvation, and call upon the Name of Jesus, He is faithful to answer and save us, and fulfill the promises He has made to glorify His people.

Read **Ephesians 1.7-10.** What stands out to you in this passage, and what stuck out to you most from the sermon on Sunday?

Read **Genesis 3.20-24.** How does this first act of clothing Adam and Eve reveal elements of the Gospel? How is the Gospel also revealed through the many tried and failed efforts of Old Testament saints?

Repent and Ask

When we are in our final, glorified state, we will be "in Christ." But Adam was only "in Adam," only able to do what he had power to do. What are ways in which you currently act "in you" and approach your faith "in you"?


