PRAYING IN JESUS' NAME

To learn anything well, we must go to those who are expert. The most expert in prayer is Jesus, who when is asked, "teach us to pray," He responds with , "pray in this way." True prayer is *not* natural to us, which is why we need to be taught.

We learn to speak to Him by knowing how He speaks to us. When we are immersed in His Word, we learn not only His promises, but how He thinks, how He loves, and what our pursuits in prayer should be.

You will pray in Jesus' Name in proportion to how much you have been spoken to by His Word.

A ROOT THAT BRINGS US WATER

John 15.1-11

Jeremiah shows us that for a tree to live and thrive, its roots must be in water. Otherwise, it dries up and dies. Jesus said similarly in John 15.1-11.

Prayer is continuing a conversation that God has started through His Word and His grace, which eventually becomes a full encounter with Him.

Repent and Ask for Provision



End the evening in a time of prayer, praying through the theme of the night using the P.R.A.Y. model with your group. Pray for these people you have mentioned and for your heart and plan as you pursue them in love. Make sure to end your time of prayer Yielding with Thanksqiving for God's sovereignty and plan for your life.
