LETTING OUR LIGHT SHINE

A significant part of baptism and public declarations of faith is the public aspect of the proclamation. We stand before not only God, but our church family, as well as those that we love that don't believe in Christ, and we make it known that we love and desire to follow Jesus. Similar to a wedding ceremony, rather than keeping our love for our spouse a secret, we want everyone else to know and see. But this also is inviting others into the story of our life.

1 Thessalonians 2.7, 8

We ought to invite people into our homes, but it ought to be for the sake of inviting them into our lives.

PLAYING HIDE AND SEEK

If God is truly God, He would not be able to be simply "found" by finite beings. If He could, He would be a terrible God. He is, by definition, as "God," above all of us, and if anyone of us could "find" Him against His best efforts, He would cease from being God. 
