Matthew 24.14 // December 8, 2019

#### THE NATURE OF THE KINGDOM

Luke 13.18-21 // Colossians 2.14, 15 // Matthew 28.16-19

Like a seed that transforms over time into a tall, fruit-bearing tree, and leaven that spreads to the very edges of a whole lump of dough, so does the Kingdom of God start small, but eventually, gradually, and even slowly grow in width, depth, height, and length.

This is made possible because of the victory of the cross. The cross, like the Allied Forces in WWII, breached the western front of the war, rendering the enemy unable to maintain his position, power, and stronghold.

- **Indicative (Because):** This is the truth that is our foundation. The "indicator" or sign that we look to as our anchor and our source.
- Imperative (Therefore): This is what we ought to do in light of the indicative. It is the command as well as hopeful result of our understanding and belief in the "Because."

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#### **COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK**

Before group starts, who can share the **Memory Verse**?

Read Matthew 24.14. What stands out in this passage, and what stuck out to you most from the sermon on Sunday?

#### **Preaching the Gospel to Yourself**

Read Colossians 2.14, 15. How does knowing that the enemy has been disarmed change how you preach the Gospel to yourself? What does this mean concerning your own self-condemnation, temptation, and how you deal with discouragement, sin, and struggles?

#### Repent and Ask for Provision

Often times we act as if we are in a losing battle. We become quite cynical, pessimistic, and a naysayer when it comes to living out our faith. This could be in our own life, or in our view of sharing the Gospel among those around us. What attitudes or actions do you need to repent of and see change in? What might you ask God for to help you turn from those tendencies and think, act, and walk differently?

#### Your Life Mission

The battle has been won for us, but the Kingdom still needs to be proclaimed through the earth. God uses us, the people of His Kingdom, to do so. What neighbors, friends, or relatives do you need to ask for prayer for as you seek to find opportunities to share the message of the Kingdom with them? What fears do you have that you need help with?

End the evening in a time of prayer, praying through the theme of the night using the P.R.A.Y. model with your group. Pray for those in your life that God has brought for you to be an ambassador of His Kingdom. Make sure to end your time of prayer Yielding with **Thanksgiving** for God's sovereignty and plan for your life.
