Colossians 3.22-4.

WORK IS GOOD

Colossians 3.22-4.1 // Genesis 2.15

Work was part of the creation when God said that everything He saw was "good." We were made in God's image, and God is a worker. So question isn't necessarily what we do, but how and why we do it.

You may be the primary means of God's grace in your co-workers lives.

MISSIONARIES IN THE WORKPLACE

1 Peter 2.4, 5, 9, 10 // 1 Corinthians 7.17-24 // Titus 2.9, 10

"Preach the Gospel, use words if necessary."

Cute...but wrong.

Falsely accredited to St. Francis of Assisi, who happened to be a fiery Gospel preacher, this phrase de-emphasizes the necessary sharing of the Gospel, which, by Greek definition, is "good *news."*

No matter where you work or what you do, where you serve or where you socialize, at the end of the day, you are the mail man.

Romans 10.13-17 // 2 Corinthians 5.17-21

HOW DO WE DO IT?

As servants, are we are either...

- Selfish: the most disatisfying of them all.
- **Selective**: serving when it's convenient. Lasts for a time but ultimately fails.
- Servant of All: Gospel-fueled and Christ-like, you get joy from giving because you have been given so much. Romans 12.10-21

Serving God by serving people is a means for God's grace in our life. It is one of the benefits of being in community; we get to Image God by being generous, gracious, and giving.

Do you want that to change?
Really?
Because let's face it, most people want their circumstances to change. Would you rather have your circumstances change(job, certain relationships, marita health, etc.), or have your heart change?
What do you think you need for this change to take place? How do you become more sacrificial and servant hearted? Here's a hint, if you were with us at the beginning of the Colossians series, you wrote the "answer" right next to Chapter 1 of Colossians in your bible
Last week, Jobey read Titus 2.11, 12. Now read Titus 9-14. Seeing this bigger context, what do we notice about how we, as servants in the work place and everywhere else, see change really happen?
Read 1 Corinthians 7.17-24. In these amazing verses, what does Paul say about where you are currently "stationed" as an ambassador and "mail man" for Christ?
How are you currently "adorning the Gospel" with your work?
What would you like prayer for when it comes to working unto the glory of God in your place of work? A better attitude of thankfulness, contentment, boldness in sharing your faith, a specific co-worker, serving in the church, being a servant in your home?
