

GOD'S DESIRES AND GOD'S WISDOM

Matthew 11.25, 26

Jesus moves from a place of declaring woes to unrepentant cities into now a declaration of praise. Even when His heart is overwhelmed, He moves into focusing on the goodness of His Father. We see Jesus' praise and approval of God's justice, but also a glorying in His mercy. Despite His approval of God's justice and judgment, it also doesn't mean that He is not mournful over the unrepentant. He laments for Jerusalem's unrepentance, and Scripture tells us that God wishes that no man would perish (1 Timothy 2.3, 4), and that He does not take pleasure in the death of the wicked (Ezekiel 33.11).

OUR INABILITY, GOD'S INITIATION

Matthew 11.27 // John 6.63-65

Because of our sin, we are separated from God and unable to be in His presence. Here, Jesus tells the people that only He truly knows the Father, and vice versa. But in an incredible act of mercy, God, through Jesus, shows mercy to some and allows them to come into relationship with Him. But though this is a gift that is "free" for us, it is not "free" for Jesus.

THE BURDEN AND THE GOSPEL

Matthew 11.28-30

At this time, the Pharisees were subjecting the Jews to laws and legalism, adding so many unbiblical requirements that they needed to do in order to be saved. The promoted a works-based salvation. Jesus here clears the path for those who know they don't have what it takes.

How do We Find Rest for Our Souls?

- Focus on the holiness of God. Reflect on the Law and the revealed picture of God we
 have been seeing so far in our Two Year Bible Reading Plan.
- Recognize the smallness, weakness, and sinfulness of yourself.
- Recognize your total inability to do what is necessary. Remind yourself that Jesus even said that our righteousness must actually exceed that of the Pharisees if we want to try to earn our salvation.
- Recognize that Jesus did it all, and offers it freely.
- Believe that it's enough, and believe that it saves you and keeps you saved.

Because Jesus is strong, You are able to admit your weakness.

Romans 8.18

Though the life of a disciple is difficult, challenging, and is a life of dying to self, the message of the cross of Christ causes our persecutions and afflictions and sufferings to seem "light and momentary," because we know that Christ took on the ultimate burden of our sin and condemnation, and we have a future glory awaiting us.

COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Read Matthew 11:25-30. What stuck out to you in these verses or was the most impactful from the message on Sunday?

What does "for my yoke is easy, and my burden light" mean? What is Jesus communicating here?

Read Ephesians 2:13. What allows us to draw near and come to Jesus in the first place?

Read Isaiah 40:28-31. What should we do when we are exhausted or "need rest for our soul" when our head knowledge of the Gospel is not lining up with our heart?

What will happen in God's timing after we wait on the Lord?

Read Luke 10:38-42. Can you relate to Martha, who was so distracted with busyness that she missed the main point of simply worshipping, abiding and spending time at the feet of Jesus?

What distractions or busyness in life are taking you away from coming to Jesus in awe, wonder and amazement? What is a great antidote to busyness and distractions? Read John 15:4 and Psalms 95:2-3.

In speaking of verse 28, Pastor Matt Chandler says Jesus is saying, "Hey, if you're exhausted, if you're bitter, if you're lonely, if you're angry, if you struggle, if you are socially inept, if you have no people skills, if you can't figure it out, come here. If you are tired, weary, come here. Are you a train wreck? Come here. Are you broken? Are you stuck in lust? Angry? Fearful? Get over here. What an invitation!" And then there is in exchange. Jesus says, "come to me, even with your (fill in the blank) and I'll give you rest." What or who do you "go to" for rest for your weary soul? Does it give you life? Does it refresh you?

For the last few months most of us have been going through Psalms in our Two Year Bible Reading Plan. What are some of the names and characteristics of God that have stuck out to you in Psalms? List them. Create a list with these titles and P.R.A.Y. to your God, worshiping His Name and who He is. Also, read Exodus 15 and Ephesians 1:7.

Now pray, remembering this truth. You are redeemed by the blood of Christ. What can wash away my sin? Nothing but the blood of Jesus. God didn't just redeem His people from slavery but from the slavery of sin! Spend quiet time praising Him for your redemption.
