# JESUS RAISES FROM THE GRAVE

The resurrection of Jesus Christ is a well known story. But what makes it so important, why is it so significant? Why, even at the time it happened, did people try to cover it up? Simply put, if it's true, if there really was a man who had the power over death itself, then that would change everything.

Romans 3.23 // Isaiah 59.2

If it is true that we have all fallen short of God's standard, what will we do to "pay Him back?" And how much is enough? And is it even possible?

## THE GOOD NEWS AND THE BAD NEWS

The bad news is that there is no way we could ever pay it back, though we will still try. We make promises or try to do enough good deeds to make up for it. But this is impossible for us, because we don't realize that our wrongs are much bigger than we think.

John 3.16-18

But there is Good News for you and for me! There was a Man who came and actually lived the life that God had desired, and He then willfully represented us before God, and He was able to pay back God on our behalf. This Man, Jesus, is the Son of God, sent to the earth to do what we couldn't do: live a perfect and sinless life, pleasing to God. And through His life and death, our sin is paid for; through His resurrection He proved that He has the power of death itself, and when we put our trust in Him, we, too, can be saved from the power of sin and death. So, though we can't get to heaven by our good works (because we simply won't be good enough), we can enter into heaven because of Jesus' good works, including His death, that He did for us.

## THE GREATEST HOPE OF ALL

To quote **Matthew 27.17**, when you see Him, do you worship Him? Or are you one who doubts? Maybe you are still on the fence, are unsure, or are maybe open to it but have questions? Maybe you call yourself a Christian, but still feel, upon closer examination, empty on the inside.

Regardless, there is hope for you and for me. Jesus was sent not to condemn you, but to save you. Do not, however, be deceived. You can't do it alone, you can't repay on your terms. It is only through the gift of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection can your eternal future be secured. Thank Him today that He finished the job for you, and that His forgiveness is complete.

# COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Read through Matthew 27:62-28:17 What stood out to your the most from these verses or the message on Sunday?

Jobey talked about a performance standard; doing good things to earn favor or "brownie points." Let's look at what Isaiah says about the matter. What part do we have in our salvation? What is it that we 'give' to God? Read Isaigh 1:11, 18, 64:6.

So with our inability to meet the requirement of holiness, one must come and fulfill the law perfectly and purely. Read 1 Peter 2.22, 1 John 3:5, and Romans 5:1-8. How does knowing and believing that Jesus lived the life that you couldn't live, died the death meant for you and then rose from the dead change your perspective of your past, present and future? In other words, how does one event that happened over 2,000 years ago change your whole life today, in 2015? Now read John 16:33. How does it give you peace? How does it give you rest?

Peter, after being restored by Jesus and receiving the Holy Spirit, spoke to the Israelites. What does he say about Jesus having to die? How does this give you comfort? Read Acts 2:22-24.

Read John 14:6. Jesus tells these things about Himself in the Gospel of John knowing that the cup of wrath awaited Him. What happens now to the one who puts his trust in Jesus? Read 2 Corinthians 5:21 and 1 Corinthians 15:42-49. How should our hearts respond?

This week, to celebrate and do something a little different in your Community Group, take some time to either write down in the space provided, or think through on your own how you would describe your life in Bad News and Good News terms. In other words, share with your group a 5 minute mini-"testimony" of what God has saved you from, and how your life has changed since becoming born again and saved by the work of Christ.

End group with praying for one another using the P.R.A.Y. model. Preach the Gospel to yourself, Repent of any sin, then Ask and last end with Thanksgiving and Yield to His will.
