## COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Before group starts, who can share the **Memory Verse**?

Read **1 Corinthians 15.20-23, 35-58**. What stands out in this passage, and what stuck out to you most from the sermon on Sunday?

### Preaching the Gospel to Yourself

So much amazing truth in these verses. What aspect of the Gospel gets you most excited as you read through these verses? And how might these truths affect your daily living?

### Repent and Ask for Provision

It is quite natural for us to get discouraged and saddened over things like sickness and suffering. However oftentimes, we can go beyond that and allow those things to dictate our worship by bringing bitterness, cynicism, apathy, and anger towards God or others. How do these truths about our resurrection bodies help us repent of when we've taken our discouragements and griefs too far?

### Your Life Mission

The sting of death has been defeated! You have been transferred from the Kingdom of Darkness to the Kingdom of Light. But there are many in your life who are still citizens of the Kingdom of Darkness. God desires for you to go as an ambassador of His Kingdom of Light.

What conversations or social settings with non-believers are coming up that you could use prayer for? Or which people in your life do you think you should reach out to for coffee or to hang out? How can your group be praying for the people in your life that you love and care for?

End the evening in a time of prayer, praying through the theme of the night using the **P.R.A.Y.** model with your group. Pray for these people you have mentioned and for your heart and plan as you pursue them in love. Make sure to end your time of prayer **Yielding with Thanksgiving** for God's sovereignty and plan for your life.
