COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

What stuck out to you the most or was the most impactful from the message on Sunday?
Read 1 Peter 3.7. What words or thoughts through these first few verses jump out at you?
Read Matthew 6.33 and Psalm 37.4 . Why is it important to seek God first, rather than the many good things that He gives us?
Read Matthew 6.25-34 . Jesus even brings up the most <i>important</i> things in life, like food and shelter, and yet He says not to worry about it, but rather seek God and delight in Him, knowing that He will provide. What makes this so difficult for us, and what can we do to live it out?
For the men and women both, what is it that you seek most in lifenot just in theory or desire or intention, but in actuality? Be very honest.
For the men (both married and single), what is the biggest hindrance for you making Christ the central part of your life as a leader?
For the women (married and single), what do you most look for in your husband (or potential husband) to make you feel secure, protected, and led well?
Women, what area can you grow in to become more the strong and supportive "co-heir" and partner for your husband or potential husband?
Men, what is the most helpful for you in your life to help you be and become the Gospel-centered leader that God wants you to be? (If mentioning wife or friends, be honoring when answering, such as "I love when my wife does" rather than "if she would only stop doing").
Read 2 Timothy 2.2-6. How are you being taught and growing in your understanding of the Word, as mentioned in verse 2? And what "civilian matters" are you engaging in that you need to get out of so that you can focus on the war at hand in order to please the One who enlisted you? Men, you can read Titus 1.5-9 and 1 Timothy 3.1-7 for some specific characteristics that are required of you (whether you are an Elder or not)
