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COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Before you begin, have people in your group share this week's memory verse with each other.

Read John 15:11. What stood out to you the most from Sunday's sermon?

Read Psalm 71:22-23 What has David seen and what is he believing that causes him respond this way? Now read Psalm 72:20. Has his life been easy or smooth sailing causing this response?

Jobey talked about things that cheapen our joy and happiness. This happens when we look for happiness and joy in the wrong places. What are some things that you depend on for joy? Read Romans 1:25. How should we respond to this sharp truth?

When we look at our lives and our failures it's easy to become disheartened and that can threaten our joy, but are we to boast in what we have done or what we can do? Read Galatians 6:14, John 16:33 and read Psalm 92:1-4. Instead of asking 'what' is our joy to be dependent on, 'who' should our joy be dependent on?

Read Psalm 34:8 and 2 Corinthians 6:10. Reflect on these verses with one another and discuss ways you may encourage one another throughout the week.

End group with praying for one another using the P.R.A.Y. model. Preach the Gospel to yourself, Repent of any sin, then Ask and last end with Thanksgiving and Yield to His will.
