PREACH THE GOSPEL TO YOURSELF

Romans 12.1, 2

WHAT IS PREACHING THE GOSPEL TO YOURSELF?

Of all human beings, you have more influence over yourself than anyone else, because you are spending all day with yourself, talking to yourself, reasoning with yourself, and making decisions.

We need to stop listening to ourselves, and we need to start preaching to ourselves.

What is Preaching? It is an attempt to communicate what we believe should filter, color, and shape how we see everything. Everyone is preaching something, somehow, at some time. Ads, politicians, friends, social media, parents, and activists all have a message of something they believe (or want) you to believe.

What are the "Gospels" that are Preached? We believe "preaching" that tells us we need more, or we are entitled to some different life or outcome. Upon failure, we preach a message of condemnation and self-hatred. We believe a message of autonomy that says we don't need to answer to anyone, as long as we feel strongly about our desires.

HOW DO WE PREACH THE GOSPEL TO OURSELVES?

Romans 12.1, 2 // Psalm 42.5

Preaching the Gospel to yourself is not just simply telling yourself, "do this," "obey the Word," or "trust God." Those phrases, in themselves, are just simply law-based commands that will result in legalism, "performancism," and self-righteousness.

But we need our actions and attitude to be an overflowing of the heart. Therefore, our hearts need to be changed. We need to be convinced, renewed, and converted.

Indicatives and Imperatives: more easily remembered as "Because" and "Therefore," when we preach the Gospel to ourselves, we need to remind ourselves of *why* (indicative/because) we should *do* (imperative/therefore).

Fear: Psalm 27 // Anxiety for Provision: Matthew 6.25-34

Condemnation Over Sin: Romans 8.1 // Temptation for Sin: Proverbs 14.12

Worry: Philippians 4.-7 // Fear of the Future: Romans 8.28

DISCIPLINE FOR JOY

With all the messages we preach to ourselves, true joy doesn't come naturally. Discipline yourself like an athlete, putting in the work and building muscle memory, to where preaching truth to yourself becomes more and more like second nature. Memorize Scripture that directly relates to your weaknesses and needs.

Psalm 119.9, 10

COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Read Romans 12:1-2. What stuck out to you in these verses or was the most impactful from the message on Sunday?

Is there anyone who has lied to you more than you yourself? Most likely, you have deceived vourself more than anyone else. What "aospel" do you typically remind yourself of? What lies are you believing about yourself?

Read 1 Corinthians 15:1, Ephesians 1:7 and 2 Corinthians 5:17. Write down the practical ways that you remind yourself daily that your past is forgiven? If you are currently not doing this, how could you start to remind yourself of this truth? When the enemy spits lies at you or you lie and preach a false gospel to yourself, where do you run?

Read Romans 1:16, 1 Corinthians 1:18 and Isaiah 40:28-31. Are you experiencing a rough season in life right now? Overwhelmed? Overworked? Overburdened? Where do you run for rest? For a re-charge? For power?

Read Acts 20:24. According to Paul in 1 Corinthians 15:2, the Gospel that saves us at salvation continues to empower us and we are constantly "being saved", or sanctified. We are given power from God to glorify Him. When it comes to His mission to make disciples, are you more of a consumer or participant? Do you count your time and energy too precious to give fully to His mission? Lately, have you been sitting in the stands fearing failure making you numb while just watching the game? Or maybe you are playing in the game but very weary and feel powerless? If you feel powerless read Matthew 11:28.

Whether you are not participating in God's mission or tired from "working in your own strength" and not resting in the power of the Gospel, we all, who put our trust in Jesus, can repent. We can turn from whatever sin is holding us back from fully experiencing God's grace and being on mission with Him. We must remind ourselves constantly of the past that we have been saved from, our current power that we have available and our future hope.

Read Revelation 21:4 Jeremiah 29:11.2 Corinthians 4:16-18 Revelation 7:9-17. What do we have to look forward to and how does this hope change your perspective and life mission?

Pray, remembering that no matter where you look, at your past, your present or your future sins, the Gospel of grace covers it. Read 1 Peter 3:18 and mediate on it.

Charles Spurgeon said, "Trembling sinner, look to Jesus, and you are saved. Do you say, 'My sins are many'? His atonement is wondrous. Do you cry, 'My heart is hard'? Jesus can soften it. Do vou exclaim, 'I am so unworthy'? Jesus loves the unworthy. Do vou feel, 'I am so vile'? It is the vile Jesus came to save. Down with you, sinner; down, down with yourself, and up with Christ, who has suffered for your sins upon Calvary's cross. Turn your eye; see Jesus only. He suffers. He bleeds. He dies. He is buried. He rises again. He ascends on high. Trust Him, and you are safe. Give up all other trusts, and rely on Jesus alone, alone on Jesus, and you will pass from death unto life."
