COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Before your group starts, is there anyone who can share the Memory Verse?

Read **Proverbs 4:25-27.** What stands out to you in this passage, and what stuck out to you most from the sermon on Sunday?

Now read **Luke 10:38-42.** Who do you typically act more like, Mary or Martha? List some examples of why you believe that.

Preaching the Gospel to Yourself

Read **Hebrews 12:1-4**, **John 1:29**, **2 Corinthians 3:18**. What particular truth in this verse can help keep you focused on the Gospel? How does the good news of Jesus Christ motivate and fuel you to stay focused on the mission God has called you to?

Repent and Confess

Read **Matthew 6:24**. What do you see in these verses that expose a particular sin or behavior in your life? Do you struggle with being distracted from what God is calling you into? If so, what is distracting you and what plan do you have to "put off sin and put on Christ?" (See **Ephesians 4:22-24**)

Ask for Provision

In light of this truth and confession, what do you need to ask for from the Lord? What fruit of the Spirit are you needing?

Your Life Mission

In moving forward in this race of life, what is your plan to be less distracted on your phone, device, or whatever else is distracting you, and be more focused on sharing the Gospel with others? How could your phone, device, or other distraction be used as a tool for the glory of God instead?

End the evening in a time of prayer, praying through the theme of the night using the **P.R.A.Y.** model with your group. Make sure to end your time of prayer **Yielding** with **Thanksgiving** for God's sovereignty and plan for your life.


