BLINDED IN A FOG

Mary Magdalene was so distraught over the present reality of Christ being dead that she couldn't see the bigger picture. Jesus was in her midst, but she didn't recognize Him, until He said her name. Often, we are consumed with the difficult stresses and realities of life, and it is difficult to see God in the midst. But when He speaks your name, do you hear His voice? Or is He just a distant, almost mythological character in an old book?

John 20.1-16 // Romans 3.23 // Isaiah 59.2

A simple belief that He existed can't save us. When we realize that we have all broken His Law, it ought to cause pause for us to consider what must be done to make things right. The bad news is that there is no way we can repay God for what we have done.

THE GOOD NEWS

The Good News is that because of His love, He came up with a plan, knowing we would be unable. He Himself would become a Man and stand in our place, living up to the standard necessary to purchase forgiveness for us.

John 3.16-18 // John 20.17-18

Jesus has made it possible for you to call God your Father. He adopts you into His family and leaves nothing left for you to do to secure your salvation.

HOPE FOR YOU

Don't have a false hope. Don't trust in your ability to appease Him by the bribery of your good deeds, you will not be able to fool Him. Jesus said, "you must be born again" (**John 3.3**). And amazingly, He says that "whoever comes to Me, I will never cast out" (**John 6.37**).

- **B:** Believe that Jesus truly is God, sent to stand in your place and save you.
