CELEBRATE GOOD TIMES, COME ON!

Deuteronomy 16.11-15

Our happiness is one measuring stick for our obedience. God, in His Word, gives us numerous commands to rejoice, celebrate, and be happy in Him, and He would not give these commands if He also did not make it possible to do so. Yet, somewhere along the line, we have made a separation between the pursuit of happiness and the pursuit of holiness. But this is not what we see in Scripture.

As part of the Jews pursuit of holiness, God ordained festivals, holy days, and celebrations to commemorate and help them appreciate and revel in what God has done.

- 7 Holidays equated to 30 days per year combined
- Weekly Sabbaths brought 50 more days
- Add in later feasts such as Purim and Hanukkah, plus occasional weddings (which were a week long) and birthdays, now you have well over 3 months per year given to celebration and feasting.
- Eating, meals, food, and wine are mentioned more than 1000 times in Scripture, with "feast" mentioned 187 times.

COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Before starting group, see if anyone can recite the memory verse for the week.

Read Deuteronomy 16:11-15. What was most impactful from the sermon on Sunday or stuck out to you in these verses?

Read Ecclesiastes 9:7-10, Psalm 104:14-15, Deuteronomy 12:7 and Ephesians 5:17-21. What do these verses communicate about what God commands of us? What words, ideas and thoughts in these verses jump off the page and stick out to you and why?

If we are called to be a people celebrating, rejoicing, being glad but currently not doing this, why not? What's blocking you from simply being in awe of God and enjoying Him? A disbelief? Disobedience? Maybe something else?

Throughout the week, if you are seeing God for who He is and what He's done, spending time in the Word, prayer and with your church family friends then going to church should build in you an excitement. This excitement should be one of our happiest moments in life, no? Similar to how happy we can be when we go see our favorite sports team, favorite band play, see a much anticipated movie, birthday party or any other joyful event in your life. If other things seem a lot more exciting than coming to church, explain how you can grow in being joyful about coming to church to celebrate. On a typical Sunday morning, when you wake up to come to church do you ever think "why am I doing this?" Or "do I really have to?" Or "it would be so much more fun if _____?" Or are you always excited to come to church? Something else?

Read Titus 2:14. Because of what Jesus did on the cross, who we are as a redeemed people, and what He has allowed us to be a part of, we should be the happiest, most joy-filled people on the planet.

What are some practical ways that you can remember, believe and celebrate what God has done for you throughout your week so that a greater excitement will be build inside of you when coming to church?

End group and your personal study time with prayer. Pray using the P.R.A.Y. model. Preach the Gospel, reminding one another of the beauty of Jesus, who gives ultimate joy and happiness to those who seek Him. Confess and Repent of any sin blocking you from experiencing joy. Then Ask for the Holy Spirit, who is your Helper and with you to continue to increase your joy. Ask Him to help you turn to prayer more, the Word more and your Gospel-centered friends. Lastly, Yield, with thanksgiving.
