HOW DO WE KILL SIN BY THE SPIRIT?

2 Corinthians 10.3-6 // Colossians 2.23

Killing sin by self strength makes you no different than any non-believer.

Galatians 3.3-5 // Romans 8.5, 6, 10.17 // 1 Corinthians 2.13, 14 John 8.32, 17.17

THE ARMOR OF GOD: WEAPONS OF WAR

Romans 12.1, 2 // Colossians 3.1-17, esp. v. 10 // Hebrews 5.14 Philippians 4.8 // Ephesians 6.11-18

> By putting on the armor of God, we go to the Gospel to defend us, and we go to the Gospel to fight for us.

TRUTHS THAT WILL SET YOU FREE

Right Theology = Right Relationship = Right Living

Propitiation: Knowing that God is no longer angry with you produces an assurance and godly confidence that He is for you, not against you. This produces thankfulness, which is a direct attack on the selfishness and pride that drives our sin.

1 John 2.2, 4.10 // John 3.36 // Romans 3.23-26 // Hebrews 2.17, 18

Justification: The only sin you can fight against is sin that is already forgiven. We must recognize that God is for us, not against us. We have been totally forgiven. If we don't *really* believe that, we'll never see victory over sin.

Justification means this miracle: that Christ takes my place and I take His. -Emil Brunner

Romans 6.6 // Colossians 3.3 // Galatians 5.24

Explation: Not only are we forgiven, but our sins are forgotten. There is no remaining stain or memory on our soul. All things are made new.

The presence of shameful guilt means the absence of faith.

COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

What stuck out to you the most or was the most impactful from the message on Sunday?

Before group, read again through **Romans Chapters 6-8.** Take your time and review which verses or phrases you marked before, and see if you understand them or if they impact you any more now than they did last week.

Before the group, look up all the verses in the **"How Do We Kill Sin?"** and **"Armor of God"** sections of the sermon notes. Mark up and take note of which verses, phrases, or truths stick out to you the most and why. Write them down and share them with the group.

What were some of the various words the bible used in those verses to describe God's Word?

What are some other words that the bible uses to speak of God's truth?

Read Romans 10.17 and Galatians 3.3-5. Where does faith come from? _____

Read **John 8.31-36**. How does Jesus relate the truth with freedom to the Pharisees? Why is it that the Gospel, the promises of God, the Word, etc., is what brings faith and ultimately is what "sets us free" from our sin?

4th Century theologian St. Jerome said "Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ." 20th Century theologian John Stott said, "there is no way to know Jesus without knowing the Scriptures." Give your thoughts on why or why not you think this is accurate. Why wouldn't other great gifts of God, like prayer, nature, and love be able to give us clear enough understanding of God to bring about the faith that we need? What makes the Word so necessary?

Only the Word gives us the detailed, specific, truth of the Gospel, our sin, our future, our hope, and God's character. How then, does (and should) knowing the Word work in tandem with the other great gifts of God, such as prayer, fellowship, and nature?

Take time to think through areas of sin in your life. Which Gospel truths can help you fight those sins, traps, and temptations?
