Read <b>2 Corinthians 5.17-21</b> . What stuck out to you the most in these verses or was the most impactful from the message on Sunday?
Romans 5.10-11. What does it mean to be "reconciled"? And who is being reconciled? Who is doing the reconciling?
Re-read <b>2 Corinthians 5.21</b> . Who made who to "be sin" and why?
Read Ephesians 1.3-7, 20, 2.10, 13, 3.11, 4.32 Romans 3.24, 6.11, 23, 8.1-2, 38-39. Grab a blank piece of paper and draw two wrapped presents at the top of the page. First label one of the gifts "To Jesus, from" Then label the other gift "To, from Jesus." List your sin that you gave to Jesus under the gift labeled "To Jesus from" And lastly, list what He gave you "In Christ" through the Great Exchange, the unfair trade. Share it with your group.  Re-read 2 Corinthians 5.17. What does it mean that a Christian is a "new
creation?"
Why do you come to church? Why are you in a Community Group? What's the main point of all of it? What are you aiming to do through it?

Maybe you have been struggling with fear, worry or apathy. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you remember these great Gospel truths throughout your week. Then give Thanks to Him for the Great Exchange, the beautiful unfairness that he has shown you.
