WISDOM FOR DIFFICULT TIMES

James 1.1-12

BACKGROUND

James was the first pastor over the church in Jerusalem (Acts 15 and 21). James wrote this letter about 7 to 10 years after Jesus was killed, in the early to mid 40's AD. James himself was eventually martyred in 62 AD for his faith. He is also known to be the younger half-brother of Jesus.

James, being a Jew and leading the church in Jerusalem, is writing his letter primarily to Jews who believed that Jesus was indeed the Messiah that God sent to save the Jewish people, hence his reference to the "twelve tribes of the dispersion."

TRIALS AND TEMPTATION

James 1.2-4

Trials and temptation are a when, not an if. The Greek word here used for "trial" and later as "temptation" is the same word. It means to "put the test" in a hostile sense.

God will take you where you haven't intended to go in order to produce in you what you could not achieve on your own.

The way you respond to difficulty will show what is most important to you. It shows what you truly value.

Do you run when there is conflict?

Comfort and self-preservation is most important to you.

Do you blow up in anger?

• Being in control is most important to you.

Do you hold grudges or go silent?

Being right is most important to you.

When there is conflict, do you just try to fly under the radar and avoid it?

• The praise of man and being accepted is most important to you.

ASKING FOR WISDOM WITHOUT DOUBT

James 1.5-12

God will give wisdom because He is good and wants to give it. But the qualifier is that we must not be double minded. This isn't simple doubt like we might think, but it means to have two agendas.

The instability of your life (outside circumstances) has nothing to do with your distance from God.

Before your group starts, is there anyone who can share the Memory Verse?

Read James 1:1-13. What stuck out to you in these verses or was the most impactful from the message on Sunday? ____

Pastor Jobey talked about how the Jewish people, God's chosen people, failed to realize that there would be no possible way to earn forgiveness. How often do you find yourself trying to 'perform' well to earn God's favor? And how often do you find yourself expecting others to perform before offering forgiveness?

Re-read James 1:2-4. When you face trial, and be honest, do you consider it joy? Jobey talked about ways that we typically respond. Which is your typical response when situations, you would have never planned for yourself, come into your life:

Do you run when there is conflict?

Do you blow up in anger?

Do you hold grudges? _

Do you try to fly under the radar and avoid it?

What is a recent example of how you have responded this way? What should you have done instead?


Why do you think you respond that way? What is ruling your heart that is causing double mindedness?

There was a quote from Paul Tripp in the sermon. "The instability of your life (outside circumstances) has nothing to do with your distance from God. It is the disloyalty of your heart." As we have seen, and as James commands, we need wisdom. Discuss in your groups which area of life, or circumstance(s), you need to change from your natural reaction to the reaction of asking for wisdom.

Read Psalm 103:15-16 and James 1:11. What happens to the things of this world? Read Isaiah 55:1-7 Do these things satisfy? James gives a picture of wave being tossed to and fro? Read Hebrews 6:17-20 What keeps us anchored in trials and uncertainty?

Spend some time as a group and pray that we would seek to see trials as an opportunity to seek God's wisdom.
