JESUS BROKE BARRIERS

John 5.19,20 // Philippians 3.10

John 5:19-20

¹⁹ Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Truly, truly, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, unless it is something he sees the Father doing for whatever the Father does, these things the son does in like manner.
²⁰ For the Father loves the Son, and shows him all things that himself doing: and greater works than these will he show Him, that you may marvel.

John 14:11-14 (ESV)

¹¹ Believe me that I am in the Father and the Father is in me, or else believe on account of the works themselves.

12 "Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do; and greater works than these will he do, because I am going to the Father.
13 Whatever you ask in my name, this I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14 If you ask me anything in my name, I will do it.

COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Read John 5.19, 20 and 14.11-14. What stuck out to you the most in these verses or was the most impactful from the message on Sunday?

When you read these two passages of Scripture, it's striking how big the claims are. John 5.19, 20 is a particularly beautiful passage depicting the oneness and love and passion that the Son has for the Father, Read **Hebrews 1.3.** Above even "dving for our sins," what was the main mission of Jesus?

Now read John 17.1, 2. Another way to word the previous question is, "why did Jesus die for our sins?" Notice the "so that" statement in verse 1. Jesus came in order to reveal the glory of God His Father. He came because God the Father wanted us sinful people to know that He is a glorious and generous Father, and so Jesus came to us to reveal the character, nature, and desire of God, coming as the "exact imprint of His nature."

Now go back to John 14.11-14. We see the same language here. Jesus desires to glorify the Father, and He even desires to glorify the Father by doing what in particular?

As we've been seeing in the past few weeks of Matthew, Jesus' desire is not just to do the whole work of God by Himself, but He graciously and incredulously invites us to be a part of it! One of the most amazing ways God the Father could be alorified is not just that His perfect Son would obey Him and do His works, but that His perfect Son would die for imperfect enemies, save them, and then cause them to desire to obey and do His works! All of this, made possible through the Son, brings glory to the Father! Therefore, Jesus tells us to do what in this passage?

Jesus wants us to ask Him for the things that glorify Him and ultimately glorify His Father. He wants us to believe in Him so that we would be ambassadors for Him. therefore bringing incredible glory to God. He desires that we would break barriers and live lives of deep faith, living for His glory, not ours.

Now, skip forward to John 15.1-11. These verses are filled with so much amazing truth, especially pertaining to what we've been looking at. What is it we do that glorifies the Father, and what is it we are called to do in order to make that happen? What is the key that unlocks are ability to glorify the Father?

Close in prayer by Preaching the Gospel to each other, Repenting of not abiding in Christ, Asking for the things that would glorify the Father in and through your life, and Yielding to His desires and plans and call on your life.
