LIVE AS YOU ARE CALLED

1 Corinthians 7.10-28

IDENTITY IN ALL THE WRONG PLACES

Paul addresses the Corinthians and their proclivity to find their identity and value and even their worth before God in other things. We tend to think that what we do makes us more valuable. But if that were true, it would mean that others are more valuable. Paul says that none of this is of any value, but rather our value comes from Christ.

Paul tells the bondservant, "you seek to be free? Guess what, you're already free because of Christ!" He says to the freed man, "you think you're free? Guess what, you are the bondservant of Christ!" His aim is to help each person, whether single, married, free, or slave, to learn to be content with their current calling and live their life for Christ, and not themselves.

OUR CALLING SHAPES OUR CALLING, NOT VICE VERSA

Paul uses the word "call" 8 times in vss. 17-24. He uses it two different ways:

- Salvific Call: Seven of the times it refers to our "salvific" call, meaning God's
 calling of us out of spiritual death and into salvation. This call solidifies our
 union with Christ.
- **Vocational Call:** One time, in verse 17 (maybe also 20), he uses it to describe what we are functionally and practically "called" to do, what we might call our "vocational" call.

What you are called to do in this life does not give value or worth to your calling in Christ.

Your calling in Christ is what gives value to what you are called to do in this life.

Galatians 5.2-15

BONDSERVANTS OF CHRIST

Paul's reminder to the singles, marrieds, slaves, and free, is that we aren't to be owned by our vocational calling (or wanting a different one), but rather we have purchased by Christ, and our calling is *not* about us, but it's about Christ.

Galatians 2.20, 21

Before your group starts, is there anyone who can share the Memory Verse?

Read 1 Corinthians 7.10-28. What stands out to you in this passage, and what stuck out to you most from the sermon on Sunday? _

Though circumcision isn't a debated theological issue we find identity in, using this example, what are some other religious actions or practices that, even if good, wrongly have us find our identity and value and worth in? What should the correct approach or perspective be with those practices?

Preaching the Gospel to Yourself

The Gospel is overflowing in these passages. What specific Gospel truth do you need to be reminded of from here? What part of the Good News brings relief and a nice, big exhale from your lungs?

Repent and Confess

In your own words, describe the difference between "salvific" and "vocational" calling. What do you struggle with as it pertains to finding your identity in your current "vocational" calling? How should your salvific calling be shaping this area of struggle?

Ask for Provision

A clear need for all of us is godly contentment. How might you ask God specifically for godly contentment in your vocational calling, while also not wanting to risk being apathetic, either?

Your Life Mission

God has assigned you your particular vocational calling in this season of life. Are you single? Married? A parent? Teacher? Business owner? How can you live your life as if it is "Christ who lives in me" in those callings? What conversations or social interactions are upcoming that you need prayer for?

End the evening in a time of prayer, praying through the theme of the night using the P.R.A.Y. model with your group. Make sure to end your time of prayer Yielding with Thanksgiving for God's sovereignty and plan for your life.
