HOW TO CALIBRATE YOUR CONSCIENCE

Romans 12.1. 2

WHAT SHAPES THE CONSCIENCE?

A Few Things That Conform Our Conscience:

- Upbringing: Demographic, Family Dynamics, Friends, Personal Experiences
- Society: Entertainment, Time Period, Region
- The Word of God

THE SEARED CONSCIENCE

Last week we looked at two types of consciences: weak and strong. But there are many nuances to this. Our consciences, whether weak or strong, can also be hardened or even seared.

Romans 2.5 // 1 Timothy 4.1-5

A Few Ways We Run This Risk:

- Convince yourself otherwise, that what you believe is okay.
- Convince yourself that this instance is okay. "This is different."
- Go with the flow of others who are like you.
- Read the bible looking for loopholes.
- Read the bible for how it affects others (opposing viewpoints)

But We Should Be:

- Acknowledging that we may be wrong.
- Observe and ask and watch others who are trustworthy.
- Most importantly, seek out truth in the Word.

HOW (AND WHEN) TO GO AGAINST CONSCIENCE

Though we should never go against conscience if we believe that it is accurate, we *should* go against conscience if we now believe that it is wrong. When we recognize that our previously held belief is actually in error, our conscience needs to be adjusted. But like a faulty warning light on your car, it will still go off according to previous calibration. This is primarily done by acting *in faith* in what you *now know to be true* according to God's Word.

Romans 12.1, 2 // 1 John 3.19-21

Conscience is like a skylight. It lets light in, but it does not create its own light.

How to Calibrate Your Conscience:

- Ask, "why do I believe what I believe?" Consider what originally calibrated.
- Ask, "where is it talked about in Scripture?"
- Pursue it with due process: be objective, seek Scripture, watch sermons, read books, talk with church leaders, lots of prayer, be patient.

Ask for Provision

Adjusting the conscience is no easy task, nor should it be taken lightly. What might you ask God for to help you in this? Do you need ideas on who you can talk to, or courage to humble yourself to learn from others?


Your Life Mission
