COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

What stuck out to you the most or was the most impactful from the message on Sunday?
List some of the things that God has given you, be it talents, personality, experience, blessings, roles, opportunities, etc.
We often serve and live life according to our own strength or comfort level. Read 1 Corinthians 15.10. When we live and act only according to what we can comfortably give and serve, we get the glory. How are ways that you can apply these verses with the gifts that God has given you?
What do you most worry about or fear? It could be unrelated to gifts and serving, but what causes the most anxiety for you?
In these fears, God wants to be glorified. He wants you to learn and believe in His power to trump these fears. He will use them to show you how strong He is. Oftentimes, He will then use these overcome fears as an incredible testimony to His goodness and power, because He used not a strong person, but a weak person who otherwise could not accomplish their feat apart from Christ. Read Philippians 4.13 and 2 Corinthians 12.9, 10.
When was a time in your life where God was glorified in your weakness? How did He accomplish something you could not have?
As our church moves into a new season, what has God been putting on your heart to be more actively pursuing in faith that you would like to see happen in your life? It could be something you are excited about, or it could be something you are totally afraid to do, but you believe that it may be something that the Spirit would want to help you grow in by His filling and empowerment.
Who in your Community Group or in other areas of your life are experiencing similar fears and are in need of seeing God's power and strength?
At the end of your CG, pray for that person, whether you pray for them corporately if it's a known need, or privately after Group. If it's someone outside of your CG, call or meet up with that person and pray for that person. Pray that the Holy Spirit would fill them grow to be strengthened by the Spirit despite their
