COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Read Matthew 18:1-4. What stuck out to you the most in these verses or was the most impactful from the message on Sunday? What do think was the disciples motive in coming to Jesus asking "Who is the greatest in the Kingdom of Heaven?" Why did they want to know this? How do we become humble like a child? What two physical and spiritual positions need to happen for us to be "great?" Read Philippians 2:5-11. At the cross of Christ, the perfect example of humility was shown to us. List other ways Jesus showed His greatness by being humble. Read 1 John 1:9, Ephesians 2:4, Psalms 46:1, Isaiah 40:26, Genesis 1:3, Romans 11:33 and 1 John 4:8. List some characteristics from these verses about God the Father. Do you know Him? What's so amazing about our Father? Read Psalms 27:4. How does turning (from sin) and kneeling (before God, our Father) practically happen?

End group and your personal study time with prayer. Pray using the P.R.A.Y. model. PREACH the Gospel, reminding one another that because Jesus has humbled Himself to the point of death on a cross now we have access to God the Father. Confess and repent of not seeing both the Bigness and Smallness of God. The Bigness that controls everything, the smallness that showed us how relational He is. Then ASK for the Holy Spirit, who is your Helper and with you to continue to increase your view of the awesomeness of your Father. Ask Him to help you turn to prayer more, the Word more and your Gospel-centered friends. Lastly, YIELD, with thanksaiving.
