THE CAUSE OF DIVORCE

Matthew 19.1-12

Jesus here states that it is God alone who authors marriage, and we see that it is also God alone who is able to give permission for a marriage to end. The implication of this are great, and important for each of us to consider deeply. He also gives us insight into a very important truth, and that's the deeper cause for divorce: the hardness of our hearts.

All sinful actions start with a hardening of the heart.

THE PROGRESSION OF SIN

The Word of God shows us that the "slippery slope" is real. However, we very, very rarely are able to see it, even when it is pointed out to us. We need the Word to show us clearly, and we need the people in our lives to bring that Word to us help us see it.

Hebrews 3.12, 13

The heart controls everything we do and say. It is the steering wheel. Lasting change always takes place through the pathway of the heart, and so heart change is always the goal, because something or someone is always ruling our hearts. Our deepest issues are not issues of pain and suffering, but issues of worship. What we worship will dictate how we respond to pain and suffering.

James 4.1, 2 // Proverbs 7.1-5, 21-27

How Desire Takes Control

- 1. Desire: "I want." Nothing wrong yet.
 - **2. Demand:** "I must." The desire is no longer an expression of love for God and man, but something I crave for myself.
 - **3. Need:** "I will." Something desirable is now seen as essential. I'm convinced that I can't live without it.
 - **4. Expectation:** "You should." This is where my relationships begin to be affected. If I believe I have a need, I expect others to make it happen if they really love me.
 - **5. Disappointment:** "You didn't!" Here the anger breaks out and becomes personal. You are standing in the way of what rules my heart.
 - **6. Punishment:** "Because you didn't, I will..." I respond to you in anger (silent treatment, hurtful words, vengeance, etc.)

DON'T HIDE: FIGHTING THE HARDNESS OF OUR HEART

Hebrews 13.13 // 2 Corinthians 10.3-7

Remembering the context of Matthew 19, we just heard Jesus talk about the need for Gospel community to come alongside to encourage, disciple, and even challenge and help bring godly discipline into our lives. We need each other to help us see what needs to be "cut off," so that the hardening of our hearts will not eventually bring about death.

COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Read Matthew 19.1-12. What stuck out to you the most in these verses or was the most impactful from the message on Sunday?

When you read Jesus' words here, why do you think he gives adultery as the one particular reason that a believer could divorce their believing spouse?

Marriage is a special gift from God to give us a picture of His love and commitment and unity with us. This is, in part, why He loves marriage so dearly. Jesus makes the point to say that divorce was not intended to be a normal or expected thing. But what happened to humanity that brought about this new possibility of divorce?

Jesus specifically gives the reason as being the "hardness of our hearts." In your own words, how does the hardening of your heart begin, and where does it lead to if gone unchecked? Be detailed and thorough, even thinking through a real example that you might share.

Read Hebrews 3.12, 13. What is the progression that Hebrews shows us? Now, read **James 4.1.2.** What does James show us that actually causes us to sin?

Look at the progression under How Sin Takes Control in the sermon notes. Can you think of examples in your own life how you have seen this pattern take place? Share that example.

What are some bad examples of how we usually try to "fix the problem?"

What is the real, and only solution for us to really put away these desires and uproot them?

Tonight, spend some time confessing sin to one another. Confess areas of your life that have gotten hardened by the deception of sin. Spend time as a group PRAYing together, and specifically ask Him to help your group get more comfortable, transparent, and real with one another.
