COMMUNITY GROUP HOMEWORK

Before group starts, is there anyone who can recite the week's memory verse?

Read **Philippians 3:12-16**. What impacted you the most from this Scripture or from Sunday's message?

Re-read **Philippians 3:12**. Then read **Galatians 5:1**, **Ephesians 1:3-14**, **Romans 8:31-39**, **2 Corinthians 5:17** and **1 Peter 2:9**. Explain in your own words how the Gospel, the good news of Jesus Christ has motivated you to press on and run the Christian race? In other words, you run *because*?

What in your past bogs you down in the present Christian race?

What is currently captivating your eyes? A good way to identify what is captivating or grabbing your full attention is by evaluating what you spend most of your time and money on? What do you think about the most?

What is the Prize that Paul is referring to in **verse 14**? Read **Philippians 3:7-8** from last week for a hint. Although we have been given the gift of salvation, how can we attain this reward? **Psalms 27:4**, **Proverbs 4:25-27** and **Hebrews 12:1-2**.

End group and your personal study time with prayer. Pray using the **P.R.A.Y.** model. First, **Preach** the Gospel, reminding yourself of the Gospel verses you read earlier. Confess and **Repent** of any sin blocking you from being completely captivated by Christ. Then **Ask** for the Holy Spirit, who is your Helper to continue increasing your desire to know Christ. Ask Him to help you turn to prayer, the Word and your Gospel-centered friendships more. Lastly, **Yield**, with thanksgiving.
