SPEAKING FROM WITHIN

Romans 8.3

God's judgment upon sin was not just technical, clerical, or merely judicial. It was deeply personal. God entered into our world and experience the treachery of sin Himself. He was personally affected by and touched by sin in a very real, tangible, and painful way. He experienced the frailty of humanity, even temptation.

He had empathy, because He dealt with our humanity from within, alongside us, not from a cold distance.

EXPAND YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD

Jesus entered into the world around us, making God Himself more easily able to dialogue with us from a place of understanding and empathy. He was then able to relate with us and to us in a way that we would connect to and understand.

We are then able to relate with others and they to us in a way that they could connect and understand the Gospel.
