TALKING BACK

Habakkuk initially has a complaint to God and receives a shocking answer: God is raising up a wicked nation in order to discipline God's very own people! Habakkuk doesn't quite know how to file this news, and so he boldly replies with a second complaint.

However, as he "talks back" to Him, Habakkuk goes with a certain acknowledgment and humility, even recognizing that he knows he is going to be rebuked.

"I SEE YOU WORKING"

One thing that Habakkuk does that is helpful to both him and to us, is he backs up and starts with what he knows as truth. He can't comprehend how God would have this kind of a plan, and rather than just argue with presumption, he steps back, takes a deep breath, and says, "okay...I know you are eternal, holy, and pure...so let me try to understand this through that lens."

Habakkuk is working out his faith. It's awkward, he is uncomfortable, but he is working. He's grappling. And God is gracious to meet him there in his desire for understanding.

THE RIGHTEOUS WILL LIVE BY FAITH

Ultimately, God desires us to have our trust and faith in Him. Not in comfort, or what we perceive as blessing, but faith in Him as our Rock, our eternal one.

God's purposes are not equal to God's approval.

Living by faith does *not* mean we live by *faithfulness*, but *by faith*. This is not to say that our faithfulness has no part in our life or discipleship, but it does mean that we are not measured, loved, accepted, or made worthy by *our faithfulness*, but that the foundation of our trust, identity, acceptance, and worthiness to be called sons and daughters of God is *only* by our faith *in Him*.


Repent and Ask for Provision

Your Life Mission

Understanding God and the way He works in this world is a helpful tool for counseling, discipleship, and evangelism. We ought to be careful how (and when) we give others our thoughts on God's role in the tragedies in our life, but what opportunities in your life with others who don't know Jesus are coming up that you need prayer for to help you come alongside them and bring them comfort, and maybe, if they are wanting it, biblical insight?

End the evening in a time of prayer, praying through the theme of the night using the P.R.A.Y. model with your group. Pray for these people you have mentioned and for your heart and plan as you pursue them in love. Make sure to end your time of prayer Yielding with Thanksgiving for God's sovereignty and plan for your life.
